The children chose from a variety of materials to create their own art work. Parents from around Cheshire arrived on May 7th to view the exhibition at the school. At 12 noon the presentation began. Highly commended paintings were awarded first. **Ruby** and **Beatrice** along with the other 8 Highly Commended artists went up to receive their £10 prize. Then the age group 2, 3 and 4 were all awarded and finally the star of the competition. The Overall Best Picture went to **Emily Domville aged 3**. Emily proudly went up to receive her prize - how proud her Mummy and Daddy were. Well done Emily we are so proud of you too! The judges comments said that Emily had painted with strong contrasts of colour and very prominent underpants and good use of green and red!
