CD=Play creatively as part of a group to act out a narrative.



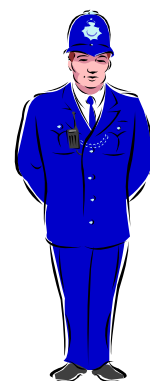
