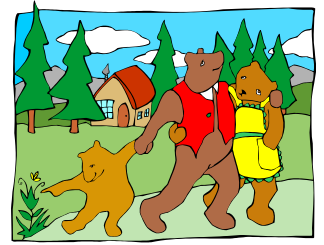


# Cocoons
